DIDACTIC UNIT 5 - ARTS AND CULTURE

Lesson plan 2

Type of love: Philia

Topic: The importance of Philia in different cultures

INTRODUCTION (10 min.)

Pairwork:

Teacher hands out the worksheet to each pair of students. Students prepare different roleplays based on the situations on the worksheet. Each pair performs one selected roleplay. Then students say whether they have any good friends from another country and whether they think that the roleplay would be different between the two of them. Is there a difference between friendships in different cultures? Students express their opinion.

DEVELOPMENT (25 min.)

Students read an article on the internet:

Groupwork: After reading the article, students are divided into groups. Within the group, they discuss what the most surprising facts of the article were and why.

Students add another paragraph to the article in which they reflect on the importance of friendship in Slovakia. Each group reads their part to the teacher. The teacher decides which group's paragraph is the most interesting.

CONCLUSION (10 min.)
